ABOUT THE ARTIST

Anna Koch is an Austrian clarinet and bass clarinet player specializing in contemporary and improvised music. She graduated with honors from the University of Music & Performing Arts Vienna in 2017. The artist has been praised for her "truly playful mind with an urge to explore the gamut of both her instrument and her imagination." Her solo program BASSticcio premiered in 2022.

Anna Koch has been selected as a representative of contemporary music for <u>NASOM</u>, the New Austrian Sound of Music, 2023/24. She is also one of the women featured in <u>CALLIOPE</u> Join the Dots, which is a project of the Austrian Ministry of European and International Affairs and the Frauenmuseum Hittisau. It features women of Austria who are shaping our society through their actions, and who are a source of inspiration.
